WESSEX WATER WORKS IN BURLEY Two representatives from Wessex Water gave a presentation to BPC on upcoming flood alleviation works in the village. These works concern foul water drainage but not surface water drainage directly and involves alleviating the pressure on the Mill Lawn pumping station. The first phase of work involves stopping infiltration of water from cracked pipes and the separation of surface water and the sewerage system from some properties., this will be completed by December. The second phase will begin in April 2022 to install plant upgrades and holding tanks under the ground in fields next to Burley Manor Hotel. No roadworks will be necessary, however there may some heavy traffic while the materials are brought into the site.

CRIME REPORTING It has been brought to our attention that there has been a spate of criminal damage through the village recently. As previously mentioned, it is vitally important that all crimes are reported - even when an insurance claim is not being made. This is because police crime figures are used to monitor crime levels and this effects the police presence in each area. It is important to call 999 when appropriate. NFDC no longer supply these to either householders or the Parish Council. They have advised that they are available from local builders merchants at a cost of approximately £4.40 each.

**FIREWORKS** November 5th is nearly upon us and some of you may be having fireworks on or around the 5th. Please make all your neighbours nearby aware of the time and day so that they can take precautions to protect any inside or outside animals they may have. Under section 4 of the Animal Welfare Act 2006, "*it is an offence to cause any unnecessary suffering to any captive or domestic animal*". The offence carries a maximum fine of up to £20,000 and/or a prison term of up to six months.
