DONATIONS A donation of £25 was given by BPC to the Burley Primary School Summer Fete fund. A grant of £100 has also been donated to Victim Support.

SUPERFAST BROADBAND Openreach are currently awaiting permission for provision of power to the new Superfast Broadband cabinet, which has agreed permission for installation at Lester Square. We will continue to keep you updated of any progress as we continue to do all we can to support this service that is vital to local residents and businesses.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC There is currently an ongoing consultative process of proposed changes to the A31 beyond Ringwood to A338. This includes an extra lane and closure of West Street.

BENCHES Some of you may have noticed that two benches have been removed from Burley Street. This is due to rotting wooden slats and degradation of the metal reinforcements in the concrete bench ends. BPC has ordered new oak replacements, which will be in-keeping with the forest environment. Watch this space!

LITTER PICK **Sunday 15th October** has been set as the date for the Autumn Litter Pick. As usual, we start at 2.30pm outside Burley Primary School. So please put this date in your diary and come & help keep your village as you would wish to see it.
