TREE WORKS Tree works by FE, discussed with BPC on a recent tree safety tour, are now proceeding. Points raised by Burley villagers have been taken into account, particularly with regard to FE supervision of the works to ensure the contractors comply with the works specification and that due care is taken with wildlife i.e. bird nesting and bat habitation.

LENGTHSMAN The Lengthsman continues to work on drainage issues to prevent flooding where possible. He is also improving the surface of the car park at the village hall, whenever the weather allows.
