ANNUAL ASSEMBLY 2021 This year BPC hosted the Burley Annual Assembly (*not to be confused with BPC's formal AGM – see above*) via Zoom on Monday 3rd May; the Chairman's report was available on the BPC noticeboard before-hand and remains

available on the BPC website. A BPC Councillor Q&A session was held with one member of the public attending. Road safety issues were discussed; these will be followed up with Hampshire Highways and we will let you know of any developments. The current programme of Broadband upgrading in Burley was also raised. We hope that next year the usually well-attended and legally required Annual Assembly will be back to normal, with the more usual format and inclusion of guest speakers from local organisations. In the meantime, it is hoped that later this year a similar style meeting may be arranged in the Village Hall to enable villagers to pursue in person matters discussed in 2019 and raise questions/make comment upon current issues of strong local interest.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC There are now traffic lights on the A35 as preliminary works continue for the Holmsley Bridge project.

SSE PROPOSALS FOR IMPROVEMENT TO LANDSCAPING Last month we reported that overhead power cables will be placed underground during a project which was due to start at the end April. At the time of writing no activity has been observed, however a program of works has been requested by BPC so that timescales can be shared.

HRH PRINCE PHILIP Following the death of HRH Prince Philip you will have seen that the village flag was flown at half-mast during the national period of mourning. A letter of condolence has been sent to Her Majesty the Queen by BPC on behalf of the people of Burley.

LITTER PICK As restrictions on outdoor activities are now lifting, a BPC litter pick has been planned for **Sunday 6th June**, this coincides with the 'Great British Spring Clean' which operates between 28 May and 13 June. As in previous years this will start outside Burley Primary School at 2.30pm; equipment will be provided. Please note that children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Social distancing must also be maintained.
