Pensions – automatic enrolment

The Council needs to decide if it should reconsider the £100 annual membership for HALC HR services following the information that automatic enrolment to a pension scheme is compulsory for all Councils regardless of any qualifying employees; significant cost will be involved in this and it is currently unknown how many companies will provide a service to Councils with no contributions. HALC are currently negotiating to provide their own pension service for Councils and it is believed that this could be at a favourable cost compared to outside companies.

<u>PC World service contract</u> The Clerk has investigated reinstating the laptop service contract with PC World. PC World will not reinstate the contract or start a new contract as the laptop is over a particular age and has had previous repairs. The options are to pay for individual repairs should they be necessary or when the laptop needs replacing take out a new service contract for a new machine.

<u>Transfers</u> £1550 should be transferred from the Jubilee to the current account to cover the jubilee film nett invoice. This leaves a balance of £351 in the Jubilee account. As two grants of £500 are currently held in the current account these can be allocated to the play area costs, meaning £89.98 should be transferred to cover the balance of these invoices from the Jubilee to the current account. This leaves a balance then of £261.02 in the Jubilee account.

A transfer of £2000 also needs to be made from the LH account to the current account to cover the LH project extension.

A transfer also needs to be made for an agreed amount from the LH account to the current account to cover the Secrets in Stone costs (see Agenda Item 7).

In line with the new Transparency and Openness code the clerk has updated the BPC website to include the following standard documents: Standing Orders, Financial Regulations, Risk Assessment, Budget, Asset Register, Annual Return sections 1, 2 & 3, year-end bank reconciliation and explanation of variances.

Correspondence
