Licensing Fairy Festival: Ref LICPR/16/07617, land at Burley Park. A Time Limited Premises Licence for the 12th and 13th August 2017 10:00-18:00 to permit Live Music, Recorded Music, Performance of Dance.

The plan is yet to be approved and must be submitted by the organisers and approved by NFDC prior to 4 months before the event; it is subject to a Code of Practice specific to this type of event.
