Burley Parish Council met on Wednesday 13th July with Cllr Philip Daubeney in the chair, and Cllrs Robert Clarke, John Cook, and Peter Egerton.

### **Public representation:**

**Greening:** A member of the public asked about progress with the Greening Project. Council advised that a council working party had been established and a budget of £1,000 assigned. Leaflets had been distributed.

**Bournemouth Airport:** A member of the public gave a report on the Bournemouth Airport Consultative Committee which she had attended on behalf of the council. The airport will only consider noise complaints made in person. The airport is looking to increase freight transport and freight aircraft are often older and noisier.;

**Finances:** Members noted the first quarter financial report: showing the council's finances are in a healthy state with adequate reserves and funds to deliver a full programme of services to the community and support for local organisations.

**Burley Village Show:** the council will have a stand showing the many projects delivered by the council over the past years.

**Casual Vacancy:** Arrangements were made for interviews and co-option to fulfil the current vacancy. A special council meeting will be held to co-opt a new member.

**Greening:** The council heard about a re-use centre set up in Brockenhurst and agreed to investigate if a similar initiative might work in Burley.

**War Memorial:** The re-cleaning of the Memorial has now been completed.

**Planning:** The council considers every planning application in detail and makes recommendations to the New Forest National Park Authority NFNPA.
