**Electricity contribution** The Council should decide what, if any, contribution should be made to the Village Hall for electricity used by the defibrillator since its installation in November 2014.

**Insurance renewal** Came & Co have sent the annual renewal notice for BPC's insurance policy. The Council must decide whether to pay £1573.23 and keep the current LTA with an expiry of September 2016 or enter into a new LTA until September 2018 with the annual premium reduced by 5% to £1494.57 .
