PUBLIC PARTICIPATION Several members of the public attended the meeting to discuss current issues. These included roads, traffic and cycling issues. BPC will investigate the possibility of a small sign on the junction of Bisterne Close and Bennetts Lane as traffic is often found in Bisterne Close looking for The White Buck. The issue of fireworks in the National Park, and their effect on animals, was also raised; Cllr Clarke suggested seeking the backing of relevant organisations such as the New Forest Equestrian Association to raise awareness. Cllr Daubeney will also speak to Mr Avery, NFNPA.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Hampshire Highways have been very helpful with many projects in Burley; BPC continues to inform them of any issues that arise. Currently Cllr Martin is investigating the “20 is plenty” scheme for the village.

GRANTS BPC has awarded grants to: Youth of Burley £100, Ringwood & Burley Band (who will be playing at the village Christmas Carol event) £75, PCSO Christmas lunch for those alone at Christmas £100.

SUPERFAST BROADBAND UPDATE As reported in last month’s magazine, formal permission for the location of a second new SFBB cabinet in Burley was required from the Verderers. At their meeting on 19th October the Verderers approved the SFBB cabinet installation of “Burley 1”, Lester Square. Cllr Martin is currently awaiting a response from Mr Peacey, HCC Superfast Broadband Team, for an update on a possible installation date.

WESSEX CANCER TRUST are holding a sponsored “Walk for Hope” on National Cancer Survivors Day, Sunday 4th June 2017, with a 10 mile and a 20 mile route. They will be holding registration/parking at Dan Tanner’s Burley Park and provide shuttle buses from the park to Woods Corner (start & end point of walk).
