PRECEPT REQUEST 2020-21 BPC has agreed that the precept (the portion of Council Tax requested by the Parish Council from NFDC) for 2021/22 should remain at £13,467. This is the fifth year that BPC has held the precept at this level without an increase. This is equivalent to £16.98 per Band D property.

COUNCIL WARD BOUNDARIES Draft recommendations have been made that, from March 2023, Burley will be part of a slightly larger ward that includes: Burley, Bransgore,

Avon, Sopley and Ringwood East. This new ward will be represented by 2 NFDC Councillors. The changes aim to improve electoral equality.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Fencing at Sandy Shoot has been requested from Highways England and the dangerous bend at the top of Pound Lane has also been reported, with recommendations to improve visibility and signage - this will be dealt with by HE after April 2021.

LENGTHSMAN The Lengthsman has cleared the ditch by the kitchen shop in Ringwood Road to improve drainage and flooding issues in this area. Several pathways have also been cleared this month. Currently he is putting hoggin down in the Village Hall car parking area; this is a weather dependent job that should make progress soon.
