ROADS AND TRAFFIC REPORT Road markings in the village centre, around Shappen Stores, have faded; these will be surveyed by Hampshire Highways and repainted as appropriate. HCC have been asked to replace a split salt bin in Forest Road. The collapsing fence along the footpath at Sandy Shoot needs looking at and repairing by Hampshire Highways, this is in hand. This month the lengthsman will be painting the old Red Cross Hut and repairing the sticking door.
