CORONAVIRUS AND HOLIDAY LETS At the time of printing holidays are still banned despite lockdown restrictions having been eased. The Government has said that staying overnight at a location other than the place you live “for a holiday or other purpose is not allowed” - this includes visiting second homes.

BURLEY WATCH Cllrs Martin and Egerton are facilitating a Whatsapp group of 20 village residents; this communicates neighbourhood watch concerns arising in the village. PC Dave Caffyn and PCSO Tracey Cooper are kept updated with current information via email and liaise with Councillors on a regular basis to maintain village safety.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC REPORT Re-surfacing work is planned to be carried out on Lyndhurst Road, from the A35 to the junction of Forest Road; this will be scheduled during 2020/21 and carried out over 2 days. Repainting of white lines is planned by Hampshire Highways (HH) in Pound Lane to discourage parking alongside dragon's teeth. HH will also paint "Slow" markings on two blind corners in Bisterne Close to discourage speeding traffic.
