LOCAL ELECTIONS The Returning Officer at NFDC has confirmed that your six current Parish Councillors were duly elected as Parish Councillors without contest for a further term; formally taking office on Tuesday 7 May 2019.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Hampshire Highways (HH) have been sent details of a recent head on collision that occurred on the Ringwood Road at the pinch points in Burley Street. As Police were not involved this will not be recorded in any official figures and therefore reporting this to HH helps to strengthen the case for further action to be taken to prevent accidents on this stretch of road. As part of continuing road maintenance, re-surfacing work has taken place in the village at: Mill Lane, Bennetts Lane and Bisterne Close; pothole repair work is also continuing. BPC is continuing to research Speed activated cameras, including possible locations in the village.

LENGTHSMAN. BPC is very pleased to announce that we have received confirmation that the Lengthsman scheme will continue to be funded by HCC for another year. This month the Lengthsman has been repairing benches in the village. A new bench seat has been ordered and this will be installed in Warnes Lane. The plaque from the original seat will be either cleaned up or replaced by a new plaque with the same wording.
