**An appeal has been lodged in respect of Appn. No. 19/00543: Land of Manor Farm, Forest Road** for Conversion of Agricultural Buildings to create Dwelling, workshop/garage; workshop/store. Following a local public meeting, BPC recommended Refusal of the application which was Refused by NFNPA on 18 Sept. 2019.

An Inspector has now been appointed to consider this appeal by Written Representations and Site Inspection. Any further representations should be made directly to the Planning Inspectorate online at <https://acp.planninginspectorate.gov.uk> by 27 January 2020 (an address is also available for written comments).

PRECEPT BPC has agreed that the precept (the portion of Council Tax requested by the Parish Council from NFDC) for 2020/21 should remain at £13,467. This is the fourth year that BPC has held the precept at this level without an increase. This is equivalent to £16.98 per Band D property.

FIREWORKS: DANGER TO ANIMALS It has been brought to the attention of BPC that Under section 4 of the Animal Welfare Act 2006, “it is an offence to cause any unnecessary suffering to any captive or domestic animal”. The offence carries a fine of up to £20,000 and/or a prison term of up to six months. As you may have read in previous BPC magazine articles and minutes, the occurrence of year-round fireworks and related injuries seems to be increasing. BPC is in discussion with NFDC, NFNPA and NFALC to address how this issue maybe monitored and controlled at a local and national level.

LENGTHSMAN You may have noticed the improved visibility at the pinch points in Burley Street. This is thanks to our Lengthsman Jon, who has cut back the surrounding foliage. Along with ditch clearing, litter picking and other jobs, Jon will soon be doing some minor maintenance work on the village clock which needs new batteries and some new parts on one side.
