

Remembrance Sunday 8th November 11 a.m

In view of the unprecedented COVID situation the usual service at the Cross cannot take place this year. The Parish Council and the Burley Branch of the Royal British Legion will have a short wreath laying ceremony, restricted to The Parish Council and the RBL. The Vicar will lead prayers followed by a Two Minute Silence. The roads will be closed as usual at 1050 hours. Although the Cross is at the junction of public highways, villagers are asked not to attend but may place wreaths or pay their respects during the day, after the ceremony. Please observe social distancing.

The Parish Council has been advised by the Director of Public Health, Hampshire County Council that the planned ceremony meets the necessary requirements. It is possible however that Government regulations may change so that the planned ceremony may not be allowed. If that were to be so, then posters will be placed in the village.

On Armistice Day, November 11th the Union Flag and RBL Standard will be lowered and a two minute silence observed. There will be no road closures and social distancing must be observed.
