ROADS AND TRAFFIC Cllr Martin reported that: he has received no feedback on the brown Sammy Miller signs from Hampshire Highways; the pothole programme is continuing; Bennetts Lane drainage work has been completed; a further request to Hants Highways has been made to resurface and re-kerb the pavement outside the Post Office; flood drains by the old Post Office have been repaired.

BROADBAND Cllr Martin attended a Broadband meeting at Minstead for an update by HCC. A new high speed broadband box should be coming soon to Burley, BT will manage this process and “Brand New Forest” are also monitoring, supporting and working with groups outside the current areas to be improved so that there are group approaches to requests for improvements.
