ROADS AND TRAFFIC It has been a busy month for roads and traffic work: A planning application has been submitted by Hampshire Highways for the Holmsley Railway Bridge replacement; it is planned that this will be discussed at an extra BPC Planning committee meeting on 6th August (since there is not a full monthly BPC meeting in August); a Traffic Management Plan has been requested by BPC. The noisy manhole covers in the centre of the village will be repaired on Friday 30th August and a road closure will be in place from 18:00-22:00. Cllr Martin has again written to Hampshire Highways requesting speed restrictions of 20mph in: the village centre, Mill Lane and Bisterne Close - this is supported by Cllr Mans (HCC). We are still waiting for a date for work to be completed on the Ringwood Road pinch point priority signs – we will keep you informed.

EMERGENCY PLAN Cllr Egerton is currently updating the Burley Emergency Plan.
