BURLEY WATCH POLICE LIAISON There have been a number of incidents in the village over the last few weeks. Residents are urged to be vigilant and secure all property, particularly outbuildings and vehicles. You may notice an increased police presence across the local area to deter any opportunists.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC As you might expect at this time of year, drainage is causing some issues due to the weather. Blocked drains in Pound Lane and Clough Lane have been reported. We would like to remind everyone of the legal responsibility of residents and landowners to keep ditches and culverts clear – particularly those that border roads and pathways.

LENGTHSMAN is also working to improve local drainage issues as they occur. The path at Sandy Shoot has recently been cleared, hoggin work at the village hall continues (weather dependent work) and monthly litter picks are carried out to try and keep the village as tidy as possible.

6th MAY ELECTIONS There are a number of elections due to take place on Thursday 6th May. NFDC are working to make polling stations COVID safe, however postal votes are being encouraged and proxy votes are also possible if you register to do so.
