If there are fewer nominations than, or the same number as, there are members on the council, the persons nominated will be elected unopposed. If there are more nominations than there are seats, a poll must be held. The notices of election will be published on Friday 22 March 2019 and nominations will be accepted from that date. Nomination papers must be hand delivered to the Returning Officer's staff (Elections Office, Appletree Court, Lyndhurst. The closing time and date for the receipt of nominations is 4.00 p.m. on Wednesday 3 April 2019.
