Subject Burley Parish Council full monthly meeting

1 Public Participation A member of the public spoke about recent pony fatalities in the village and the effect of speeding, increased traffic and proposed signage. Cllr Egerton spoke about research that Burley Primary School are doing into slowing traffic.

It was discussed that CCTV signage will be displayed around the village. There is already CCTV covering other areas around the centre of the village.

4 Approval of Minutes of the full BPC meeting held on 10th November 2021 Having been previously circulated, the Minutes and Clerk's report for the last meeting were agreed and signed.

5 Matters Arising and Clerk's Report. As shown in the Clerk's report the balance of the current account on 23rd November was £12,404.97. The payments detailed in the Clerk's report were approved. Cllr Egerton confirmed that he has reconciled the online statements for November with the Clerk's report.

Holmsley Bridge felled trees – a response has been received from the contractors confirming the trees removed were those agreed in the contract.

Shell garage at Picket Post have cut back foliage to improve visibility.

Cllr Johnstone agreed to liaise with McDonalds on litter picking (VJ).

Wayleave for affordable homes – Cllr Clarke has received copy of an agreement for lease from Mr Avery NFNPA.

Repairs done by dragon machine – the road has been re-repaired.

An NFDC by-election will be held on 23rd December following Cllr Steele's resignation.

A NFNPA enforcement officer has been contacted regarding Spencers estate agent lights.

Agreed: Following an introductory meeting to the Greening Campaign, BPC membership costing £50 will be arranged by Kate Hedge.

6 Vacancy for Clerk/RFO & locum appointment A locum clerk, Mrs E Manship, was appointed; to remain in place until an appointment is made in the New Year.

7 LDDN relocation Cllr Egerton reported that four people from HCC are visiting Deer hall on 13th December, along with BPC Councillors, to assess the building for repair or alternatives.

8 Maintenance of village environment Cllr Clarke has submitted proposals to FE for tree planting of 12 Jubilee oaks. 9 trees remain at the site from planting done for HM Queen's Silver Jubilee in 1977. A proposal for 8 new trees in Pound Lane has also been submitted. Cllr Clarke will meet with FE on 17th December to discuss.
