NOTICE OF CASUAL VACANCY TO BE FILLED BY CO-OPTION

A vacancy has arisen in the office of Councillor for Burley Parish Council. The vacancy will be filled by co-option as no request for a by-election was received by 8th June 2022.

Applications are invited by not later than 15th July 2022 from any qualifying* person wishing to apply for the position.

Application should be made in writing, to the Clerk, giving personal details and relevant background and qualifying criteria.

Those considered eligible for the position will be invited to attend an interview, after which the Council will decide upon whom it wishes to co-opt to complete its membership.

***NOTE - A Qualifying Person is one who is registered as a local government elector for the Parish of Burley or, during the whole of the 12 months preceding the date of their application:**

- a) Occupied, as owner or tenant, premises in the Parish, or**
- b) Whose principal or only place of work has been in the Parish, or**
- c) Resided in the Parish, or within 4.8 kilometres (3 miles) of the Parish**

AND

- a) Has not been given a custodial sentence of more than 3 months in the past 5 years.**
- b) Is not subject to a bankruptcy order.**
