BPC GRANT A grant of £100 has been awarded to Victim Support following a recent application.

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY A road closure application has been submitted by BPC in anticipation of the annual Remembrance Day parade in the village. However, at the time of writing arrangements are currently unknown due to the changing COVID restrictions on public gatherings.

BROADBAND UPDATE Following the announcement that householder grants are available from the government to improve broadband in rural areas, BPC is facilitating the organisation of lists of interested Burley householders. Once collated these will be sent to Openreach who evaluate the properties and provide a quote for the installation of fiber direct to the properties. Grants of up to £3000 are available on a first come first served basis. ROADS AND TRAFFIC The increased volume of traffic over the summer has resulted in requests from householders for both alternative and additional traffic calming measures in the village. BPC is looking again at the possibility of a temporary Speed Indicator Device. We will let you know more in due course.

CYCLING UK Cycling Events (one of the major organisers of cycling events both nationally and in the New Forest) has a new director, Mr Ben MacWilliam who has committed to reducing the number of participants in their cycling events to a maximum of 1000. This would make these events compliant with the New Forest Cycling Event Organisers Charter – this is welcome news.

AUTUMN LITTER PICK We are currently investigating whether it is possible to hold our usual BPC autumn litter pick in the light of current COVID restrictions. If we are able to go ahead on 18th October the event will be publicised on posters throughout the village, as well as on the BPC website. Despite both Jono (our Lengthsman) and the newly introduced New Forest Ambassadors scheme contributing regularly to litter picking, we still need all the help we can muster to help keep Burley tidy as well as beautiful.
