EMERGENCY PLAN UPDATE As shielding will end for most at the end of July, the pharmacy and Shappen Stores are now asking people to collect prescriptions and food themselves wherever possible. A third of deliveries are currently being maintained by the Emergency Plan volunteers. It is intended that deliveries will continue throughout next winter to those that remain vulnerable.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC REPORT 'Slow' signs have now been painted on the dangerous corners in Bisterne Close and the white lines have been refreshed in Pound Lane. A request has been made to NFDC to clear the sand debris made by badgers, from the footpath on the Ringwood Road towards Burley Street (Stocks Hill). A site visit took place on the proposed footpath from the village car park to Chapel Lane to run through exact requirements. We are awaiting a more detailed plan to be presented which will be

used as the basis to request permission from the interested parties (HCC, Forestry England & Natural England).
