Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer Vacancy

Tom Brindley has now left us to join another Parish Council locally. We welcome back in his place Mrs Shelley Gale who previously served as our Parish Clerk for almost nine years up to 2022. Shelley is well known to many in the village and will take up post again on 1st August.

Hants CC Residential Homes

Cllr Mans reported that HCC are to build three new residential homes for the elderly, one of which will be in the New Forest; some older homes will be closed but there will be a net gain of 100 residential places across the county.

Little Deers Day Nursery

BPC are working closely with HCC on plans to build a replacement building for LDDN Trustees in Campden Park, as the present old wooden structure is nearing the end of its working life. This an important resource for Burley & surrounding area which BPC is determined to keep supporting. Discussions with HCC engineers are now progressing well.

Ringwood Road Traffic

Discussions continue with Hampshire Highways to find a solution to the patently dangerous bottleneck and very narrow pavement by the Old Farmhouse Tearooms.
